WIDOW/WIDOWER EXEMPTION APPLICATION

An additional property tax exemption is available to widow(er)s. This exemption removes \$500 from the taxable value of the home and can reduce the annual property tax bill by \$10.00 to \$14.00 depending on the location of the property.

Any widow(er) who is a permanent Florida resident may claim this exemption on up to three properties. If the widow(er) remarries they are no longer eligible.
